Exams are free to military personnel. Eligible civilians must pay \$90 (\$70 exam fee/\$20 administration fee) payable by credit card and/or money order; no personal checks. Exams are computer-based and the results are received upon completion of exams. The CLEP examinations are timed-90 minutes exams. No points are deducted for incorrect responses. Study materials are available at the Base Library, plus you can register on the web and take practice tests at no charge.

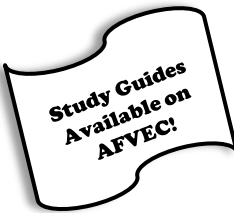
