Eligibility

DePLAYment Tag Passes are issued to active duty members deployed for 30 days or more in support of an active operation and documented on official orders from 1 July 09 to 30 July 2010. Qualified family members are defined as spouse and/or children with DoD I.D. cards. It also includes family members that are sponsored and have DoD I.D. cards (i.e. sponsored parent, sibling, etc.)

The following categories may qualify for DePLAYment Tag Pass Packs.

- Air Force active duty members with qualified family members.
- Deployed Air National Guard (ANG) and Air Force Reserve (AFR) personnel with qualified family members.
- Air Force Wounded Warrior (AFW2) members with or without qualified family members.
- Family members of Fallen Warriors with DoD I.D. cards.
- Army/Navy/Marines Active Duty members ONLY when officially assigned to an active Air Force Base with qualified family members.

What do I need to pick up a DePLAYment Tag Pass Pack?

Your active duty sponsor may bring in their deployed orders to obtain a DePLAYment Tag Pass Pack. If your sponsor is already deployed, you may pick up your DePLAYment Tag Pass Pack with a copy of your sponsor's deployed orders.

Where can I get a DePLAYment Tag Pass Pack?

The packs will be distributed at the front desk of the Schilling Community Center. Once you receive your DePLAYment Tag Pass Pack, you will need to log on to www.myairforcelife.com to register. Please follow additional information provided to you by the Schilling staff to properly document and register your passes.

Once registered, you may use your tag pass for discounts and free programs wherever you see this sign.



How to use your pass

- ★ Look for specials and programs at your Force Support Squadron facilities identified with the above logo.
 - To sign up for youth classes and sports, visit the facility offering the program and present the child's tag pass.
 - You will be asked to sign a log verifying the class or sports sign up for accounting controls.
- ★ For family programs, simply visit the facility offering the program and present a tag pass.
 - You'll be asked to sign a log verifying the use for accounting controls.
- ★ To redeem hourly child care, contact resource referral to ensure they have hourly care options. All other CDC requirements must be met in order to use your hourly child care benefit.

Where can we use the DePLAYment Tag Passes?

The DePLAYment Tag passes may only be used at participating FSS facilities on an Air Force base. Army, Navy, or Marine Bases will not accept the passes.
