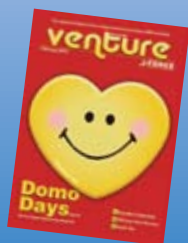

Squadron Party and Picnic Funds

Each squadron and Associated Unit on Kadena AB is allocated \$6 per military member assigned as of 1 October. Funds may be utilized throughout the fiscal year for squadron functions, (i.e., squadron, picnics and purchases at commissary or AAFES outlets, holiday functions at Officers' Club, NCO Club, and Airmen's Club). All functions must be open to all squadron members and may be utilized to purchase food and drinks only, no alcoholic beverages may be purchased. Squadron Commanders request the funds a minimum of 15 days prior to the event, and must be approved prior to any expenditure being made. At no time will a function be approved after the fact. Point of contact for all requests should be directed to 18FSS/FSRF, 632-7215 or 632-7218.

Squadron Outdoor Recreation Rental Items

Each Squadron and Associated Unit on Kadena AB is allocated \$3 per military member assigned as of 1 October. Funds may be utilized to rent Outdoor Recreation (ODR) rental items, (i.e. tables, tents, chairs, coolers, etc.), to support your squadron functions. A request must be made in writing, signed by the squadron commander listing the items needed a minimum of 15 days prior to the event. Sample letters are available at ODR as well as the availability of equipment required for your function. Letters will be submitted to ODR and an invoice will be prepared. Request should be directed to 18FSS/FSCR, 959-2850.

Private Organizations

Private Organizations (PO's) properly sanctioned and approved by 18MSG/CC and limited Unofficial Private Organizations (unofficial Private Organizations are those small organizations that do not exceed \$1,000 in a bank account over a three month period) may conduct fundraisers on Kadena AB. No organization may conduct more than two fundraisers per quarter. All fundraisers must be submitted to 18FSS/FSRF a minimum of 15 days prior to the event, no exceptions will be granted. Fundraisers will normally be granted for a maximum of one to two days. Exceptions would be holiday haunted houses (four days actual operation). At no time will official government e-mail be utilized in connection with fundraisers or membership drives. Point of contact for all requests should be directed to 18FSS/FSRF, 632-7215 or 632-7218.
